ENGINEERING PROJECTS

First Year Group Project: Renewable tidal energy device and offshore platform in the Bristol Channel (*First-Class Honours*)

Selected and researched a Venturi tidal generator over 7 months, alongside a commercial plan for a subsea data centre. Led turbine blade design, optimising foil profiles and pitch angles to maximise efficiency. Used SolidWorks CAD in a multidisciplinary team to build a physical, laser-cut and 3D-printed prototype for an academic showcase.

EPQ Artefact - Van Interior Conversion Design (A* - 100%)

Independently designed a full van interior using SolidWorks CAD, creating a 3D-printed scale prototype to optimise long-term travel ergonomics and storage. Grounded the development in material constraints and primary and secondary research gathered through questionnaires and online seminars, concluding with a formal presentation.

A-Level Design & Technology/Product Design: NEA: Micro cooking (A* - 95% coursework)

Designed a bespoke, compact food preparation, storage, and cooking unit that integrates seamlessly into the rear of a Mini One. Developed an original design brief and executed all NEA stages, including in-depth open-ended investigation, research, iterative development, full-scale prototyping, and final evaluation.
